1. Install Windows & apps in a VM
2. Download & run Image Assist to capture the image
3. Test the image using the Image Assist USB drive
4. Upload the image for factory engineering
5. Review & approve First Article
6. Place orders

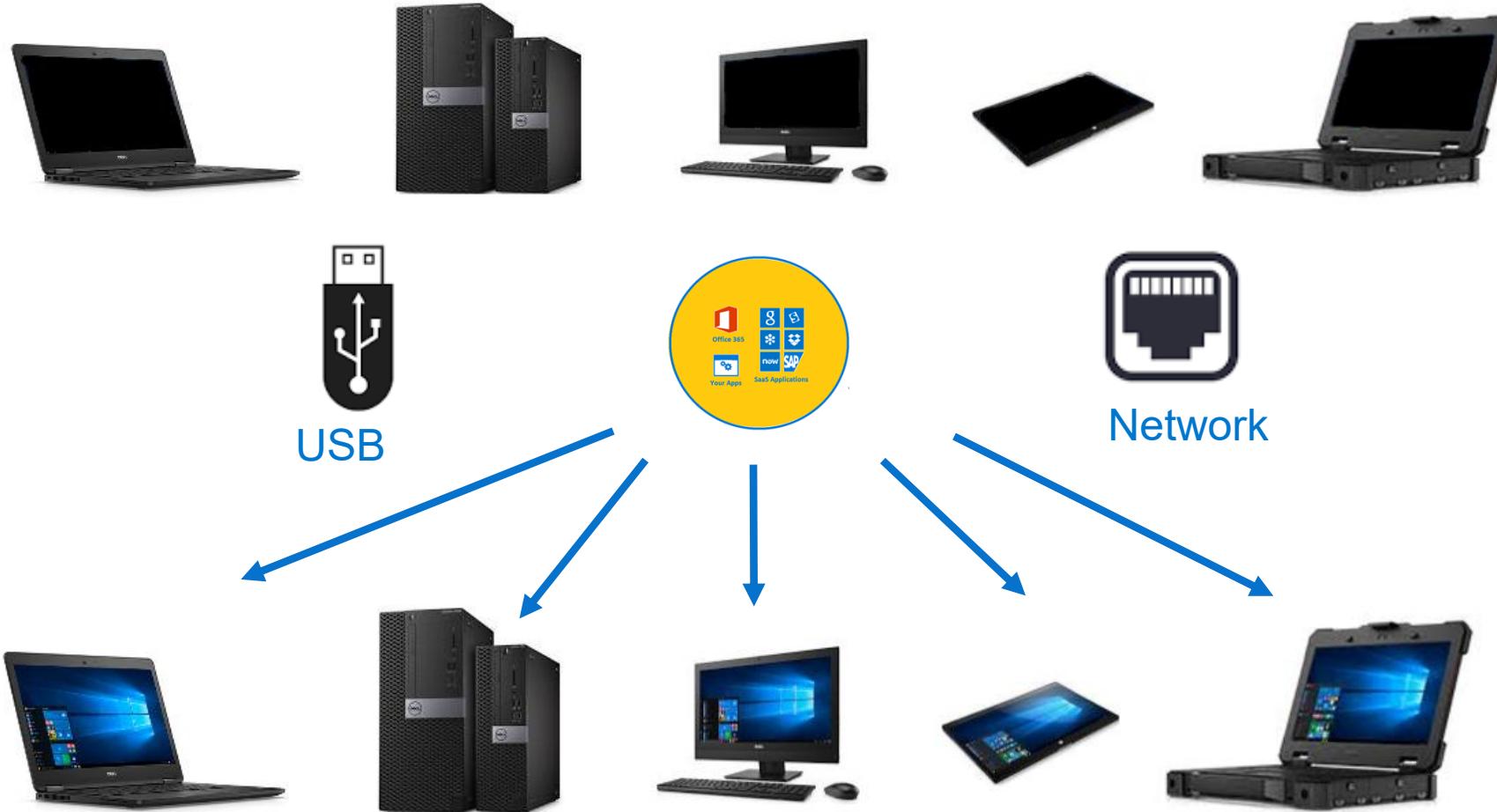
